## Code of Conduct for Safeguarding Children \& Young Adults

The Little Sisters of the Poor's Apostolate is Care of Elderly. Our aim is to provide a safe environment where safeguarding children and young people is of paramount importance.

We uphold positive safeguarding practices and provide to Staff, Volunteers and those who use our property:-

- A copy of the National Board for Safeguarding Children in the Catholic Church in Ireland
- Staff and Volunteers are asked to read and sign that they have read and understood and will adhere to the NBSCCCI standards and procedures.
- We operate within the Church's principles and guidance and any specific procedures
- policy for visiting children
- Treat all children \& young people who visit the Home with dignity \& respect
- All staff and Volunteers must report any potentially abusive behaviour
- Immediately report incidents of alleged abuse and poor practice to the designated person (The Home's Manager) who will follow the correct procedures and document
- Maintain confidentiality about sensitive information
- Encourage an anti-discriminatory outlook
- Develop \& maintain appropriate working relationships with all staff \& volunteers
- Never participate in, behaviour which is illegal, unsafe or abusive


## Staff \& Volunteers have the right to:

- access to ongoing training (Safeguarding the elderly with the same principles for children)
- support in reporting suspected abuse
